

Robofest Participant LTU Scholarship:

High School Seniors who have participated in Robofest at any time in any division, and who are planning to attend LTU for any degree program can apply for a \$3,000 annual renewable scholarship (for a total of \$12,000 over 4 years).

Submit an application and a letter of recommendation from one of your Robofest adult coaches or mentors, along with a 400-word essay describing your Robofest experience and your career goals, to apply. Robofest can assist with the letter if requested.

Deadline date: April 1st

Robofest Champion LTU Scholarship:

Each team member of the top 3 Senior Division Game, Exhibition, RoboArts, RoboMed, UMC and Vcc teams at the World Championship events will receive a scholarship certificate to attend LTU:

- 1st Place: \$20,000 annual scholarship (\$80,000 for 4 years)
- 2nd Place: \$16,000 annual scholarship. (\$64,000 for 4 years)
- 3rd Place: \$14,000 annual scholarship. (\$56,000 for 4 years)

Students receiving these scholarships must enroll at LTU the same year as their High School graduation, and must meet LTU admission and scholarship criteria of High School GPA of 3.0 or better.

Scholarship is renewable each year provided the student is enrolled for a least 12 credit hours each semester and maintains at least a 3.0 GPA.
